*Dear River Valley Community Church Brethren,
Here is the update of our ministry this month of March to April, 2017.*



This is the Camanga Church located in Camanga Island in Coron, Palawan, Philippines. Camanga Island used to be full of believers of Christ. NTM-Filipino missionaries had shared the gospel to this place. After many years, however, the missionaries left and trained only one man to be the pastor. A couple of years ago, the man died leaving no Biblical materials and no trained leaders. The result? Some believers went back to worshipping other gods. Only a few were left still waiting for more teaching. Upon learning this, **Peter was burdened and prayed to visit the church. He longed to help the believers create disciples and train others to stand and continue on in their faith.**



This past March, Peter flew to Coron and then hired a small motorboat to get to Camanga Island. It was a long boat ride, the ocean rough, a bit scary and he was quite seasick. Despite it all, he still enjoyed seeing the richness of the underwater reefs surrounding the islands of the Tagbanua Tribe. Praise God for the missionaries who spent their lives living here and reaching the different Islands of Tagbanua for the Lord!



When Peter arrived on Malawig, an island close to Camanga, he met the leaders of the Tagbanua church. There they discussed the problem of the Camanga church. **The Tagbanua leaders also shared Peter's burden regarding Camanga and they prayed together about it.**



The NTMPI leadership have decided to send Jehd Alberto to the Camanga island as a missionary. He is a newly recognized missionary of NTMPI from two years ago. Before he goes, Peter will take some time to disciple and train him in preparing lessons for the Chronological Bible Teachings (CBT). **Peter and Jehd are working now on the Old Testament lessons and have already finished more than ten lessons.** They plan to have lessons that span from the Creation, in Genesis, to the Ascension of Christ, in Acts. **Ochie is teaching Jehd to type using her laptop.** As Jehd is learning to type faster, he types the finished CBT lessons on to the computer.



We were able to hold a seminar about the CBT Theology with the help of our friend and fellow missionary, Cesar Ferrer. The missionaries to the Palawano tribes attended. The missionaries told us how encouraged they were by the seminar. They felt more equipped to be effective in ministry through using CBT theology.



We are still raising funds to buy a four-wheel drive vehicle, to be used in reaching churches and other NTMPI missionaries in the remote mountainous tribal areas of the Philippines. A used FJ cruiser of our co-missionary is selling it for US\$18,000. A promised donations is now:
